A NOTE FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Without going too deep or pseudo-psychological, BUYER & CELLAR talks a lot about "stuff," but at its heart is not about "stuff."

It's a **very funny and very human** play, about a very real and famous person in a fictitious story. And about a man who works for her, gets to know her, and discovers maybe a little too much about her life. Although I am not usually drawn to stories of the rich and famous, this one stands out because it manages to be **both sympathetic and critical** in its examination of the price of fame, and never sycophantic.

We move through this foreign Malibu mansion basementmall world alongside our narrator, Alex, and it is from his changing perspective we meet and engage with the grand lady.

Jonathan Tolins' play works its magic on a few levels, as a **delightfully witty monologue**, as a **biting satirical social commentary** on celebrities and narcissism, and as a **love story of sorts** (or really two love stories). How fortunate we are to have the creative energies of Jude and Jack and Elizabeth as our guides, along with a bevy of UVA student designers, and the ubiquitous Mimi. Welcome to the Founders Cellar!

A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Celebrity can be seductive ... but talent is eternal.

Barbra has undeniable talent—you can tell from a single note. So what does an icon like Barbra do with all her wealth and time when she's no longer performing? Meticulously curate her own utopia with "relentless good taste," of course.

What struck me most in rehearsal for this show was just how little Jonathan Tolins invented about Barbra (and James) and their hideaway estate in Malibu. Tiny details that Barbra mentions in the book and in other public interviews all make it into the play.

Yes, the Oprah book tour interview happened (Kathy Griffin gives a hilarious summary—look it up), she has told the hot water bottle story multiple times, and even Fifi is real (although that may not be her name). Yes, she does blow bubbles! Barbra really does think the stage "People" dress is better. She says so on page 217. And yes, Barbra will eat just ice cream for dinner. Why? Because she can. The Seth Rogen road movie exists. It's called *The Guilt Trip*. It's all in the book.

The only thing in the script that isn't true about Barbra is the way she behaves. That, we may never know (until the memoir is released in November).

One thing we can be certain of is her *Passion for Design*.

RUSELL PETRO | Scenic Designer


